MAY 31 – JUNE 1	Tour Cork City, Cobh, and Killarney
JUNE 2	Explore the beautiful Dingle Peninsula
JUNE 3	See the Burren, Cliffs of Moher, and Galway
JUNE 4	Experience the area of Connemara
JUNE 5	Visit (London) Derry in Northern Ireland
JUNE 6	Attend a Gaelic sporting match in Dublin
JUNE 7	Visit Belfast in Northern Ireland
JUNE 8	Depart for the U.S.

LOGISTICS AND COST The cost of the trip is **\$4,600** and will be billed as a lab fee, in addition to your Spring 2010 tuition. Airfare, airport transfers, in-country transportation, lodging, daily breakfast, entrance fees, and guides are included in the program fee.
